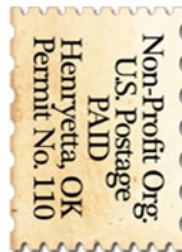

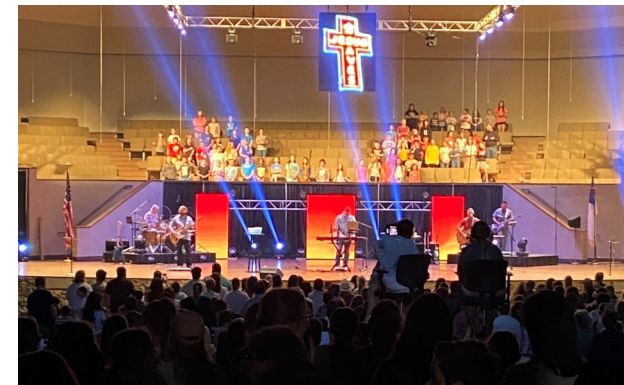


Many of our churches participated in Associational Children's Camp at Falls Creek June 1-4. ACC is a unique and exciting time of Worship, Fellowship, and hearing from God's Word.

Including both sessions there were a total of 5,316 who registered for camp. More importantly 455 children gave their hearts to Christ. There were 680 total decisions recorded.

Praise the Lord for what he has done and will continue doing in the lives of these children and sponsors. Pray for churches, families, & friends as they encourage those who made decisions.

Those in attendance gave a record offering of \$7,807.12 to the Venezuela Crisis Response Lottie Moon Challenge. The funds will help Venezuelan refugee children, and Venezuelan pastors and their families. What a wonderful way to show God's love by caring for those in need.
